The squad may be young, but every player is here on merit. They've shown great maturity in recent weeks, and we all have full confidence that they'll keep growing and competing at this level.

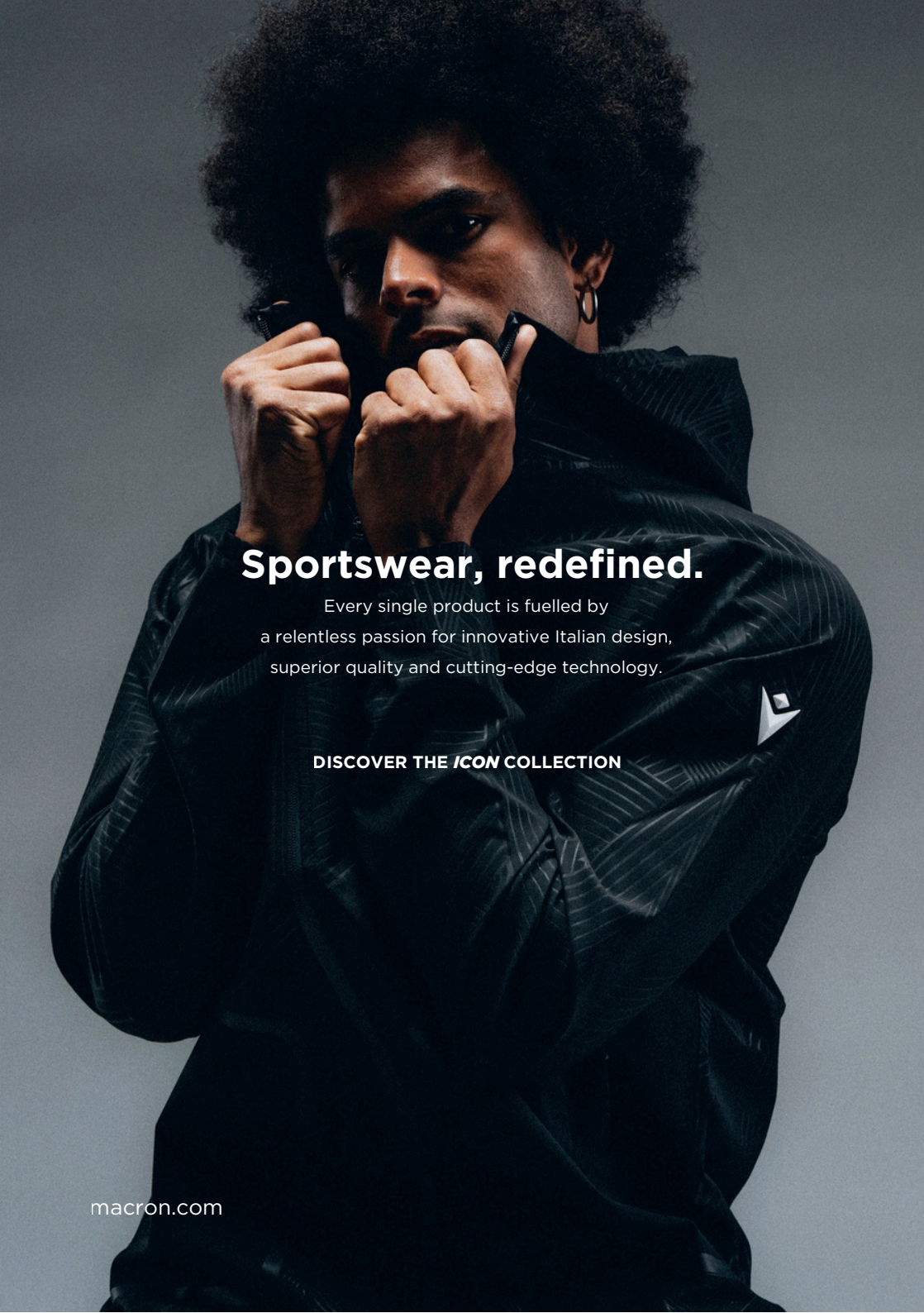

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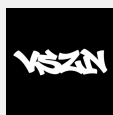
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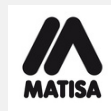
