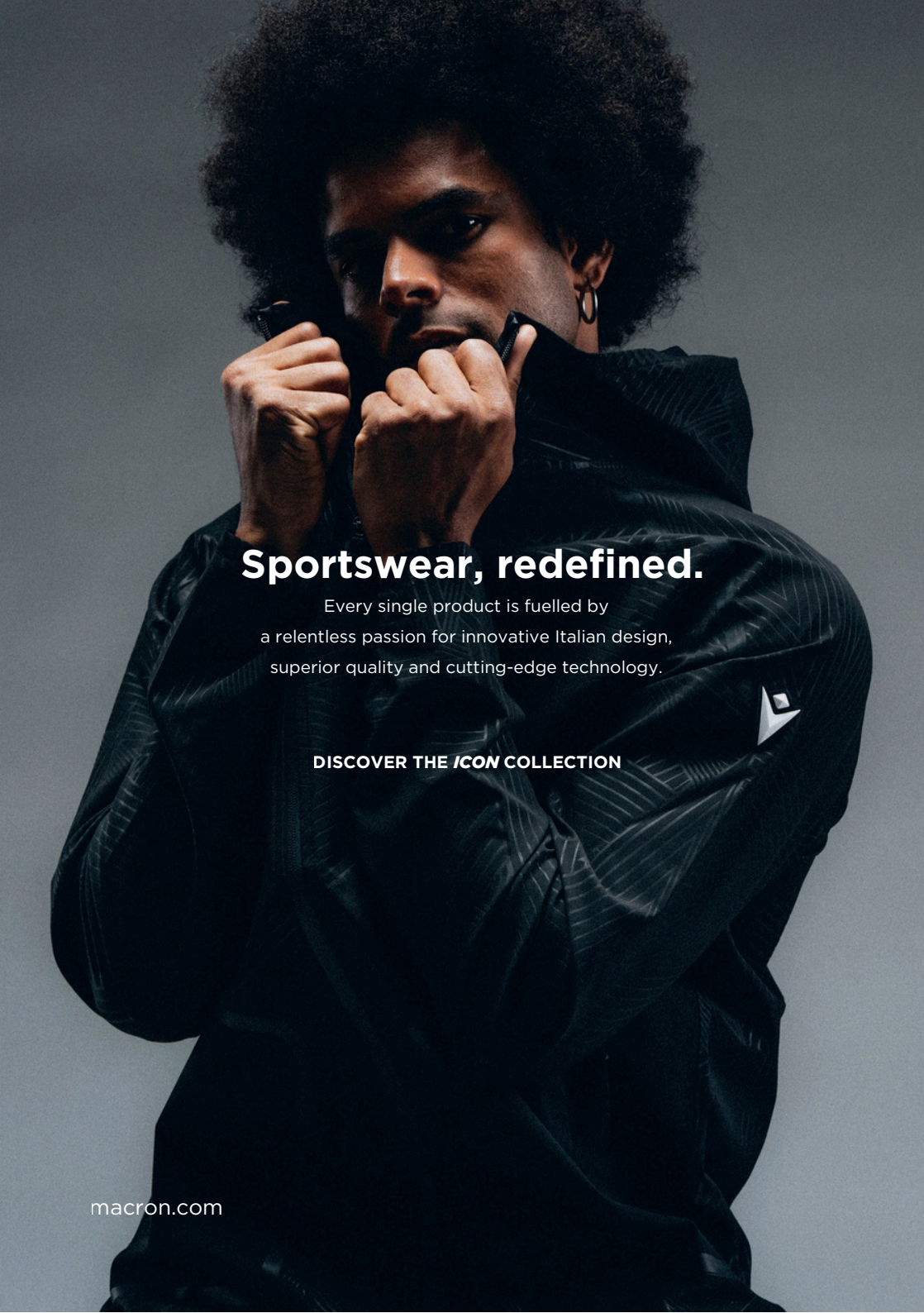
There's a positive vibe in the group, we're confident in our direction, and we're ready to push on from here. Let's enjoy today and get right behind the team once again.

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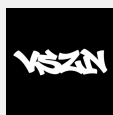
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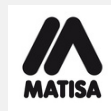
