Have a wonderful Christmas and a Happy New Year. Here's to an exciting and ambitious 2026 for Leeds UFCA.

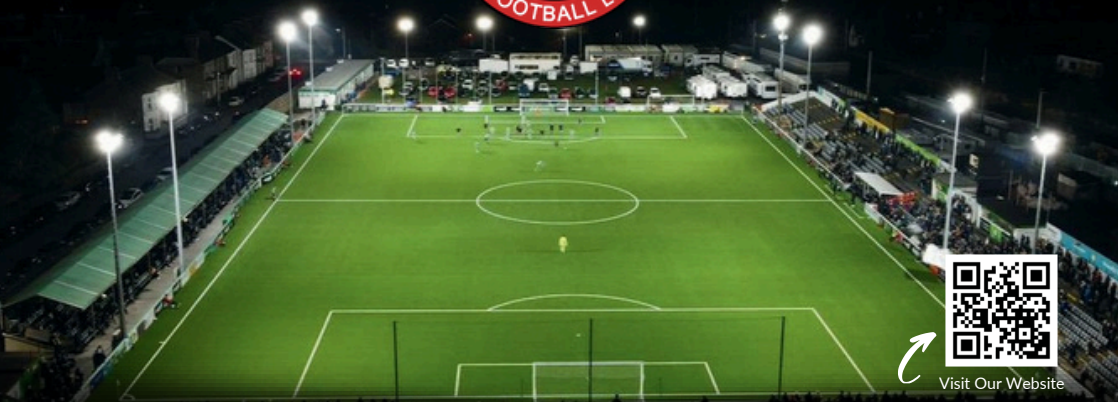

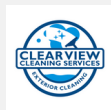
