GEORGE BROWN SCORES FOR SHEFFIELD WEDNESDAY

Congratulations to UFCA Graduate and former Leeds UFCA star George Brown, who made his EFL Championship debut for Sheffield Wednesday at the weekend.

Brown marked the occasion in style, finding the back of the net in the 50th minute to help secure all three points for the Owls. The 19-year-old striker had previously featured twice for Sheffield Wednesday's first team in the Carabao Cup, making appearances against Leeds United and Grimsby Town, but this was his first start in the league - a milestone moment in his young career.

The striker joined the Owls in September 2024 following a successful trial period, after graduating from the UFCA Scholarship Programme. Before moving to Hillsborough, Brown had a remarkable season in the Yorkshire Amateur League with Leeds UFCA, netting 47 goals in 26 appearances.

UFCA Director Steve Hart said: "We're incredibly proud of George and everything he's achieved so far. From his time on the UFCA Scholarship Programme to scoring on his first Championship start, it's a testament to his hard work, determination, and talent. He's a perfect example of what our academy aims to do - develop players who can make an impact at the professional level."
